Official Raffle Rules

Raffle proceeds support Montgomery Child Care Association, Inc., a registered 501(c) (3) charitable organization headquartered at 3204 Tower Oaks Blvd., Suite 330, Rockville, Maryland 20852.

DESCRIPTION OF RAFFLE

The raffle grand prize will be a \$500.00 credit toward one month's tuition at any MCCA child care center. Additional prizes will include gift baskets and sporting event tickets.

HOW TO ENTER

The raffle begins on April 12, 2017. Raffle tickets may be purchased in advance from designated MCCA staff members at MCCA child care center locations through May 5, 2017, and at MCCA May Fair on May 6, 2017 from 10:00 am until 1:00 pm (at 9805 Dameron Drive, Silver Spring, MD 20902). MCCA employees and their immediate families are not eligible to participate. All raffle ticket sales are final; no refunds will be made.

RAFFLE DRAWING

The final raffle prize drawing will be held at MCCA May Fair on May 6, 2017, at 1:30 pm. Winners will be randomly selected and need not be present to win. Entrants must be 18 years or older to win. Void where prohibited or restricted by law. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.

WINNER NOTIFICATION

Winners will be announced at the drawing by name, and will be contacted by phone or e-mail based on the information on their ticket stub, within 3 business days of being drawn. Failure of the raffle winners to respond within 10 business days of the raffle drawing date will constitute a forfeiture of the prize, and a new winner will be selected. The prize may be forfeited if selected entrant(s): (1) cannot be reached; (2) cannot accept or receive prize for any reason.

MCCA is not responsible for any delays or obstacles in notification due to (a) erroneous contact information; (b) any outage or delay in Internet service or access; or (c) any other circumstances which may delay or prevent a winner from receiving the prize notifications.

ELIGIBILITY AND LIMITATIONS

Winners need not be present to win. MCCA employees and their immediate families (spouse, children, siblings, parents, grandparents) are not eligible to participate. This raffle is only open to U.S. Residents at least 18 years of age, and is void where prohibited or restricted by law and is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. MCCA is not responsible for any entries that are late, misdirected, incomplete, or altered. MCCA reserves the right to cancel the raffle for any reason.

AWARDING THE PRIZES

Except as stated herein, there shall be no substitution allowed for the prize by a winner. A prize winner, however, may transfer the right to claim the prize, but may not transfer it to MCCA employees or their immediate families, here defined as spouse, children, siblings, parents, grandparents.

If the grand prize is to be applied to the tuition of a currently enrolled MCCA family, it will be credited to the family's account on the next monthly statement.

If the grand prize is to be applied to the tuition of a newly enrolling family, the family must comply with MCCA's standard enrollment procedures, including signing an enrollment contract and completing all required enrollment forms.

The tuition credit prize cannot be redeemed for cash.
