



As they played, the teachers encouraged the babies to use their senses to explore the materials further by holding up the shells to their ears so the babies could hear the “ocean waves” and helping them to use their fingers and hands to explore the different textures and shapes of the shells. They also enjoyed cooling off by splashing in the water and moving the cool, wet sand through their fingers.
