


Painting with Rolling pins

This week, the Tadpoles teachers provided the children rolling pins, paint and pieces of paper and encouraged the children to dip the rolling pin in colorful paints and roll it back and forth on the paper. As they worked, the children noticed that the rolling pin created unique designs on the paper. Providing a variety of tools and materials for art experiences, help children to build on their imagination and creativity as they discover how to use familiar objects in different ways.





Making Home Made Biscuits

The Tadpoles had the opportunity to make their own homemade flaky biscuits following a real recipe. With the help of their teachers, the children identified the different items needed to make the biscuits such as flour, butter and salt and then used their emerging math skills as they measure out what was needed to make the dough. The Tadpoles used the small muscles in their hands as they controlled the wire whisk to mix all the ingredients together. After the biscuits were cooked and cooled, the children enjoyed them at snack time where the teachers had conversations with them about how the biscuits tasted and recounted how they had made them earlier in the day.





Exploring Alphabet Soup With Ladles And Bowls

This week the Tadpoles enjoyed “cooking” and serving bowls of “soup” full of letters of the alphabet. The teachers added small letters, ladles and warm water to a large container and encouraged the children to simmer, stir, scoop and pour the soup into bowls for their customers to enjoy! Not only was this fun pretend play opportunity for the Tadpoles that allowed them to take on different roles, it also challenged them to identify the letters in the “soup”.
