



Removing Corn Kernels From The Cob

The Tadpoles teachers planned for an activity for the children to use the corn collected during their field trip to Sharps Farm last week. The children were challenged to use the small muscles in their hands to remove the kernels from the corn cobs. While working on the task, Maxwell thought we could save the grains to make some popcorn later. This was this a great opportunity for the children to explore natural materials as they strengthen their fine motor skills and eye-hand coordination.
